Day 4: Siem Reap to Kratie | Scenic Drive Through Cambodia's Heartland

Set out on a full-day drive from Siem Reap to Kratie, passing through picturesque countryside, quaint towns, and bustling markets. Stop at Cambodia's oldest surviving pagoda before taking a local ferry across the mighty Mekong River to Koh Trong Island, a car-free haven where time seems to stand still and rural life thrives.



Day 7: Mondulkiri | A Day with Elephants in the Jungle

Spend an unforgettable day at the Elephant Valley Project, where you'll learn about conservation efforts while shadowing two elephant families in their natural habitat.
