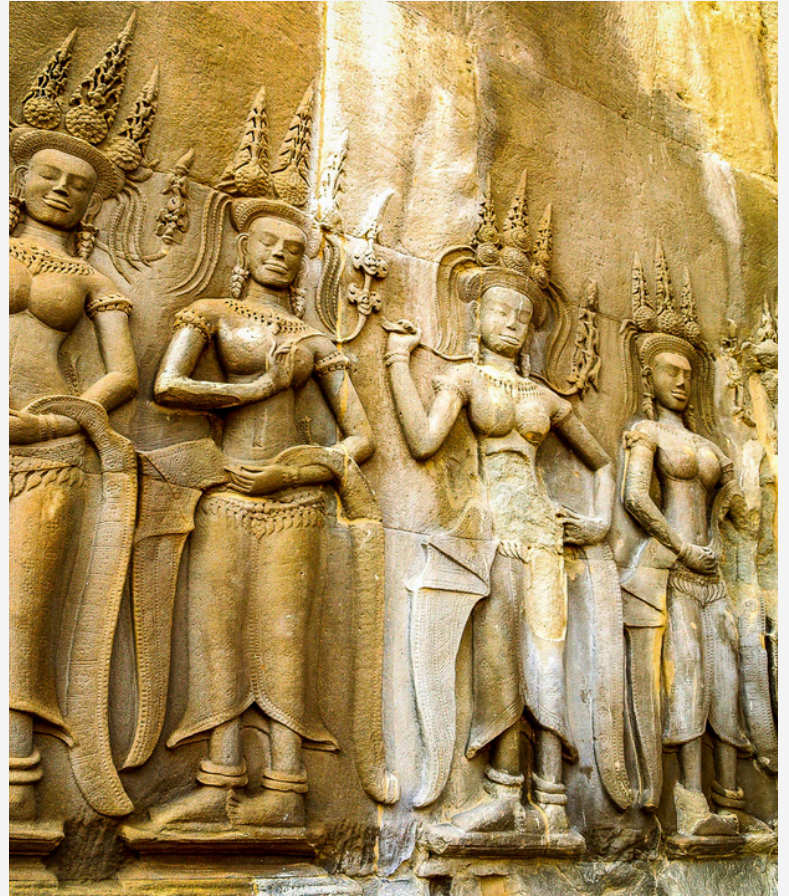
Day 4: A Taste of Cambodia – Cooking, Charity, and Community
