Under his expert guidance, you'll have the chance to sit at the potter's wheel and shape your very own pottery piece using up to five lumps of fresh clay. By participating in this workshop, you not only gain hands-on experience but also contribute to the important mission of the centre, which provides free vocational training to disadvantaged youths in the community.
